## Personalized Plans of Care Managed by Registered Nurses

Each of our clients has an R.N. who serves as their Care Manager, *at no additional charge*. Our R.N.'s meet with our clients and their families to create the initial plan for home care. In creating the home care plan, a holistic assessment is completed by the R.N. to ensure that each client's care plan addresses all of their needs that relate to living at home. Our R.N.'s continue to make frequent visits to our clients' homes to update their care plans according to their changing needs. The R.N.'s also supervise the care that our caregivers are providing. The primary role of our R.N.'s is to do whatever is necessary to ensure that our clients are living their best possible life, *at home*.
